



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT HOURS (PDHs)

Continuing professional education for licensed engineers is measured in professional development hours (PDHs). A PDH is 1 contact hour of instruction or presentation. Continuing Education Units (CEUs) readily translate into PDHs (10 PDH = 1 CEU), though PDHs do not convert automatically to CEUs.

This form may be used to track Professional Development Hours (PDH) for attendance at a poster, panel, or technical session at this meeting. PDH credits are awarded for participation in these activities and are normally accepted by accreditation agencies responsible for professional registration.

It is responsibility of the attendee to select session(s) appropriate to your license and needs. Contact your accreditation agency for their rules, sponsor/provider status and specific course/session approval.

IEEE PES does not keep records of who attended what session or meeting. If you are audited, it is your responsibility to provide authenticating documents (i.e. conference registration receipt, conference programs, etc.).
